









































## LESSON 39 (NÍIPO PIHXÍKOPUTO)

### Vocabulary:

**pihxípo, pihxípi** (an.), **pihxípoyi** (in.) = ninety;

**PIHXÍPiaw** (an.), **PIHXÍPOiaw** (in.) = there are 90.

**áiPIHXÍPOSTUYIMIw** = he/she is 90 years old.

**PIHXÍPOISOPOXÍHZAw** (an.), **PIHXÍPOISOPOXÓHTOhp** = costs \$90.

**ANISZI: áuANISZI, áuANISTOTOAw, áuANISTOhp** = to do, make, obey, mind (the root -TOT- may be the most basic element; cf. **APISTO-**.)

**AXISAWO:** \_\_\_\_\_, **áuAXISAWATAw**, \_\_\_\_\_, = to visit

**áuaxisawo-w** = a guest, visitor

**AZA:** \_\_\_\_\_, **ÁZAw, ÁZTOhp** = to lose

**áuAZI** = to be drunk

**AZISTO:** \_\_\_\_\_, **áuAZISTOTAw**, \_\_\_\_\_, = to persuade (cf. TOT).

**AZISTOTOKI, AZISTOTOAw**, \_\_\_\_\_, = to cheat

**aikístan** = a rodeo, horse-breaking

**áiPISKI** = to expound, fence in, corral;

**pískan (i)** = a corral, buffalo-pound or buffalo jump

**PISZIXÍSTO:** \_\_\_\_\_, **PISZIXÍSTOTOAw**, \_\_\_\_\_, = to deceive (cv. TOT).

**POTO:** \_\_\_\_\_, **ihPOTOAw, ihPOZIHp** = to put, loose, pardon, let go, lay down, set free; **potokit!** = let me go!

**ANI: (áu)ANI, (áu) ANISTAw, (áu)ANISTOhp** = say, tell, call, name; **za kitániko?** = what's your name? what are you called?

**SIZIPSA: áiSIZIPS (i) & áiSIZIPSAKI, áiSIZIPSATAw, áiSIZIPSATOhp** = to speak, talk (to); to read (in the intransitive).

### Irregular T-Stems:

The T-stem verbs have irregularities in centripetal forms and in the indefinite passive: that is, T disappears before the K. The loss of the T is likely to result in a contraction of vowels that now come together. Here are samples of the indefinite passive:

nitohPAoko = I am carried;

nitohKoko = I am given (something by someone);

nitÁNIko = I am called or named; kitÁNIko (note loss of S).

Samples of centripetal forms:

nitohPÁok; nitohKOK; nitÁNIk; nitáiSOPOAHZISAk;	he/she—> me
kitohPÁok; kitohKOK; kitÁNIk; kitáiSOPOAHZISAk;	he/she—> you
otohPÁok; otohKOK; otANIk; otáiSOPOAHZISAk;	4th —> 3rd person
nitohPÁokinan; nitohKOKinan; nitANIkinan;	
ihPÁokiw; ihKOKiw; ANikiw;	3rd/4th us (excl. & incl.)
nitohPÁokiw nitohKOKiw nitANikiw	they me
nitohPÁokinaniaw; nitohKOKinaniaw; nitANikinaniaw;	they us (excl.)
